

**Andrea M. Russo, MD, FACC, FHRS**

Dr. Russo is Professor of Medicine at Cooper Medical School of Rowan University, Director of Electrophysiology and Arrhythmia Services and Director of the CCEP Fellowship Program at Cooper University Hospital in Camden, N.J. Prior to joining the faculty at Cooper, she was a member of the faculty at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine in Philadelphia, PA from 1997-2008 and was Director of the Electrophysiology Laboratory at Penn Presbyterian Medical Center.

Dr. Russo is currently the President-Elect of the Heart Rhythm Society (HRS), member of the HRS Executive Committee, and member of the HRS Board of Trustees. She is also a member of the AHA Get-With-the-Guidelines Atrial Fibrillation Clinical Work Group, member of the ACC Cardiovascular Disease in Women Committee, and member of the ABMS Continuing Board Certification Commission.
